FIRST FULL WEEKENDS IN MAY & NOVEMBER ONLY**

* May Free Disposal Weekend for fridges/freezers/air-conditioners, mattresses/sprung bases (any size), clean metal and e-waste only. Must be transported to waste centre. Conditions apply for free disposal.

** November Free Disposal Weekend for bulky household general waste and clean metal only. Must be transported to waste centre. Conditions apply for free disposal.

*** Collections due to take place on Good Friday will occur the following Saturday.

Printed on 100% recycled paper and is recyclable. Remove magnet before placing in your yellow bin. Turn over for waste and recycling advice.

GREEN BIN

FOOD AND GARDEN ORGANICS (FOGO)

- All garden organics and food waste goes in the green bin, either loose, or in an AS4736-2006 certified compostable bag. If you choose to use bags, we prefer you to use the compostable bags which are available for free from Council to ensure they are actually compostable.
- Food produces methane gas when it breaks down in landfill so it's very important to put it in the green bin for composting.
- Used pizza boxes, paper towel, tissues and shredded paper can go in the green bin - all other paper/cardboard goes in the yellow bin.

YELLOW BIN

COMMINGLED RECYCLING

- DO NOT PUT YOUR RECYCLING INSIDE A PLASTIC BAG
- Commingled household recycling includes empty household packaging such as plastic bottles and containers marked with the triangle symbol and any number 1 to 5 inside, glass bottles and jars (lids off), paper and cardboard, and aluminium and steel cans.
- No soft plastic packaging (including plastic bags, cling wrap and scrunchable plastic containers), polystyrene, face masks, food, broken glass or large containers such as oil or pesticide containers.

RED BIN

GARBAGE

- Everything you put in your red bin goes to landfill, where it takes up valuable space and is a lost resource.
- Some items like nappies must go in the red bin.
- Plastic bags should be avoided, and can be taken back to a collection point at the supermarket for recycling. If you need to throw one away, put it in your red bin.

DISPOSING OF ASBESTOS

Goulburn Waste Management Centre accepts correctly wrapped asbestos for disposal at the same price as mixed waste. To bring asbestos to the centre, you must book by phoning the Waste Info Line on (02) 4823 4417 or the Gatehouse on (02) 4823 4839.

BIN PLACEMENT

Please place bins **1 metre apart** and away from cars, caravans and other obstructions. If your bins are obstructed, they may not be emptied. Bins must be returned to the property promptly after collection.

COMPOST

Council uses your food and garden waste to produce high quality compost, which is available for sale at Goulburn Waste Management centre on weekdays 8am-12pm and the first full weekend of each month 8am-12pm (subject to availability).

SLOW DOWN

Take care when driving past waste collection vehicles. Staff are regularly working alongside the vehicles.

MEDICAL WASTE

Medical waste must go in dedicated medical waste containers and bins. Talk to your medical professional for advice.

HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL CLEANOUT

An annual **Household Chemical CleanOut** is held for domestic quantities of chemicals and some hazardous waste. Phone the Waste Info Line for more information.
