### **Subject: Rural Waste Service**

---

Please find enclosed your new Rural Waste Card for use from 1 July 2018.

Council is continually working to improve local waste services. This year we are implementing a new electronic rural waste card system, which will eliminate the need to issue new cards every financial year, as the cards will be able to be used over multiple years on an ongoing basis. This new system will also enable misplaced cards to be cancelled and reissued more effectively.

Please keep this card safe as a replacement fee applies as per Council's Fees and Charges. In order to get a replacement card, you must provide Council with the Card Number listed above, so please make a note of this.

Each financial year, the card enables one standard waste disposal per week (i.e. 52 standard waste disposals) and one large waste disposal per year for bulky household general waste. The amount and type of waste you are to dispose of for each standard disposal remains the same as last year, as outlined on the enclosed fact sheet.

Multiple waste streams are accepted with the Rural Waste Card, such as household general waste, fencing wire, steel and timber. This excludes hazardous materials such as asbestos or materials with a per-item charge at Council's Waste Management Centres (e.g. mattresses, fridges, tyres etc.). One large waste disposal is provided each year enabling the disposal of up to two cubic metres of bulky waste on one occasion. Please refer to the conditions of use over the page.

Council staff will check and inspect loads to ensure only acceptable items are included and the correct number of standard waste disposals are recorded. To check the number of disposals you have remaining on your card, ask at the Waste Management Centre when you present your card or call the Waste Info Line (02) 4823 4417.

### **Rural Waste Card Conditions of Use**

- Rural Waste Card holders must follow the reasonable direction of staff at all times.
- Replacement cards will incur a replacement fee as per Council's Fees and Charges.
- Owners who have not received their card in the initial roll-out have until 31 August 2018 to request a replacement card in order for the fee to be waived. After this date, the replacement fee will be applicable.
- Refunds may be issued and the rural waste service cancelled if unused cards are returned by 31 August 2018. After this date, no refunds will be issued. Refunds will not be issued for cards from previous years.
- The card is attached to a property. If a property is sold, the card must be given to the purchaser.
- It is the responsibility of the owner or agent to forward the card to tenants.
- Cards issued for new dwellings or purchases where a card had not been previously issued will allow one standard waste disposal per week for the remainder of the financial year.
- All load variations outside of those specified on the table on the Rural Waste Card Fact Sheet will be charged the relevant tipping fee. Other quantities of waste, including loaded trucks, will not be accepted on the card and the relevant fees apply.
- Waste with a per-item tipping charge is not accepted on the Rural Waste Card – this includes mattresses, fridges, air conditioners, animals, tyres etc.
- Rural Waste Cards cannot be used to dispose of asbestos or other hazardous waste.

### **Household Chemical CleanOut – July 2018**

A free Household Chemical CleanOut is planned for Goulburn and Marulan on Saturday 28 July 2018. The event is happening at Council's Hetherington Street Depot in Goulburn from 8am to 11am, and at Marulan Waste Management Centre from 1pm to 4pm. You can take household quantities of the following household chemicals and items – up to a maximum of 20L or 20kg of a single item. The following items are accepted free of charge:

ChemClear and drumMUSTER also provide options for the disposal of rural chemicals and containers.

### **Bulky Household General Waste Disposal Weekend – November 2018**

A free disposal weekend for bulky household general waste disposal will be held at all three waste centres on 3 and 4 November 2018. Loads are limited to a maximum of 2m<sup>3</sup> per household and must be fully sorted or fees will apply as per Council's Fees and Charges. Anything above this amount, or any waste with a per-item charge (e.g. mattresses, fridges, tyres etc.) will be charged as per Council's Fees and Charges.

### **Mattress, Fridge, Air-conditioner and E-waste Disposal Weekend – May 2019**

A free disposal weekend for household mattresses, fridges/freezers, air-conditioners and e-waste disposal will be held at all three waste centres on 4 and 5 May 2019. Loads are limited to a maximum of 2 mattresses, 2 fridges/freezers, 1 air-conditioner and 1m<sup>3</sup> of e-waste per household. Any other waste will be charged as per Council's Fees and Charges.
