<sup>\*\*</sup> November Free Disposal Weekend includes bulky household general waste, organic waste and clean steel only.

Must be transported to waste centre and waste streams sorted for recycling/composting. Conditions apply for free disposal.

\*\*\* Collections due to take place on Good Friday will occur the following day.





# **GREEN BIN**

## Food and garden organics (FOGO)

- All garden organics and food waste goes in the green bin, either loose, or in a certified compostable bag. We prefer you to use compostable bags available from Council to ensure that they are actually compostable.
- Food produces methane gas when it breaks down in landfill so it's very important to put it in the green bin for composting.
- Used pizza boxes, paper towel, tissues and shredded paper can go in the green bin all other paper/cardboard goes in the yellow bin.



# **YELLOW BIN**

### Recycling

- DO NOT PUT YOUR RECYCLING INSIDE A PLASTIC BAG
- Co-mingled household recycling includes empty household packaging such as
  plastic bottles and containers marked with the triangle symbol and any number
  1 to 5 inside, glass bottles and jars (lids off), paper and cardboard, and aluminium
  and steel cans.
- No soft plastic packaging (including plastic bags, cling wrap & scrunchable plastic containers), polystyrene, food, or broken glass or large containers such as oil or pesticide containers.



## **RED BIN**

#### Garbage

- Everything you put in your red bin goes to landfill, where it takes up valuable space and is a lost resource.
- Some items like nappies must go in the red bin.
- Plastic bags should be avoided, and can be taken back to a collection point at the supermarket for recycling. If you need to throw one away, put it in your red bin.

#### **DISPOSING OF ASBESTOS**

Goulburn Waste Management Centre accepts correctly wrapped asbestos for disposal at the same price as mixed waste. To bring asbestos to the centre, you must book by phoning the Waste Info Line on (02) 4823 4417 or the Gatehouse on (02) 4823 4839.

#### BIN PLACEMENT

Please place bins 1 metre apart and away from cars, caravans, trees and other obstructions. If your bins are obstructed, they may not be emptied. Bins must be returned to the property promptly after collection.

**SLOW DOWN** and take care when driving past waste collection vehicles. Staff are regularly working alongside the vehicles.

An annual **Household Chemical CleanOut** is held for domestic quantities of chemicals and some hazardous waste, such as paint, gas bottles, fluorescent light globes, batteries & pesticides.
