2009/10	Improve pedestrian amenity in Auburn Street by:
	Landscape improvement at the two "gateway" entries e.g. Auburn/Bradley and
	Auburn/Clinton intersections and selected central mid-block and intersection locations
	Grant funds - \$60K COMPLETE
2010/11	Multi Storey Parking Station investigation; begin Auburn Street amenity and pedestrian safety improvement themes:
	Engage consultant to undertake feasibility study for multi-storey parking station,
	improved parking eg Sloane St and links to Auburn Street
	Redirect traffic out of Auburn Street (by signage) and into Bourke and Sloane Street alternatives
	Introduce zebra crossings into Auburn Street mid-blocks
	Trial scramble crossings at selected intersections
