That:

- 1. The report on proposed amendments to the Goulburn Mulwaree Development Control Plan (DCP) 2009 in relation to water and sewer servicing in urban areas and the associated changes in the Water Supply, Sewerage (On-site and Reticulated), Stormwater and Trade Waste Policy be received.
- 2. Council publicly exhibits the proposed amendments to DCP 2009 Section 3.18 Urban Servicing (Water and Sewer) and to the Water Supply, Sewerage (On-site and Reticulated), Stormwater and Trade Waste Policy for a minimum period of 28 days.
- 3. In Marulan Council will not consider rezoning of rural or environmental land intended to be served by public reticulated water and sewer systems until the proposed Marulan Waste Water Treatment Plant is operational.
