



Goulburn Mulwaree Council's Councillor Profile

Cr Alfred Walker has a long term family history in Goulburn and has served as the Chairperson of the Pejar Local Aboriginal Land Council for over six years. He has worked in the social services industry since the age of 19. He has been a committee member on Office of Environment and Heritage's Karst Management Advisory Committee and was involved in the establishment the Goulburn Mulwaree Youth Council.

Cr Walker represents Council on the Youth wellbeing committee and Performing Arts Centre working party where he is the chair.

Cr Walker's family ties to the Goulburn area stretch back thousands of years. He was born in Nowra whilst his family was on holiday and grew up in Goulburn. Cr Walker is a member of Goulburn CDAT, Keeping Them Safe, Youth Interagency, Aboriginal Interagency, Pejar LALC, Vibe 3on3, Community Services Local Area Action Plan, and has previously been a member of OEH's KMAC & the Argyle Society (ceased). Cr Walker is often called upon to perform Acknowledgments of Country with the permission of the Aboriginal elder and community.

Cr Walker aims for equal representation and advocacy of all age groups and demographics, promoting Goulburn Mulwaree's resources and lifestyle; encouraging a balance between big and small businesses; increase community involvement and participation in decision making. Cr Walker would also like to increase community involvement for 18-35 year old residents in Goulburn Mulwaree; increase leisure activities and interest around our water sources such as the Wollondilly River Walkway project and ensure better health and wellbeing services which includes mental health for 12-40 year old citizens.

In 2012 he was named Goulburn Mulwaree Citizen of the Year.
