



Goulburn Mulwaree Council's Councillor Profile

Cr Denzil Sturgiss has lived and worked on the land in the Tarago district for most of his life. He has been a shearer, rural contractor, and property manager. He now lives and works on his own small grazing property on the Tarago-Bungendore Road with his wife Anne, where they run some fine wool merinos and harvest truffles during the winter months.

Cr Sturgiss was first elected to Mulwaree Council in 1999 and re-elected to Greater Argyle Council, later to become Goulburn Mulwaree Council in 2004. He was re-elected in 2008 and recently in 2012. Cr Sturgiss currently represents Council on the Recreation Area Committee and the Performing Arts Centre working party.

Within the community, Cr Sturgiss is a life member of the Tarago Sporting Association, a member of the Tarago Hall Association, a member of the Tarago and District Progress Association, a member of the Taylors Creek Rural Fire Service and a member of the Woodlawn Bioreactor Community Liaison Committee.

Cr Sturgiss has a special interest in improving sport and recreation facilities with ready access to them for the rural population, as well as improving access to services for rural villages, such as water, sewerage and waste removal.

He is also interested in providing more sealed and safer rural roads and is especially active in progressing the rural bridge replacement program. During his time in office Cr Sturgiss wants to continue to make sure rural ratepayers have a voice in Council and that they receive a fair share of Local Government services.

In 2014, Cr Sturgiss received the Local Government NSW "Certificate of Service" for his 14 years' service to the people of Goulburn Mulwaree.
